# Facing Academic Integrity Threats (FAITH) Conference



The <u>FAITH Conference</u> will be organized as a three-day event between the 5th and the 7th of August 2024 under the premises of <u>Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University</u> (COMU) in <u>Canakkale</u>, Türkiye. Canakkale, which has lands on both Asia and Europe continents, is located in the western coast of Türkiye, alongside the Dardanelles connecting the Sea of Marmara to the Aegean Sea. In addition, Canakkale is home to the <u>ancient Troy city</u>, which is listed under UNESCO World Heritage Convention.



COMU, with its 48.309 students, is a modern university state and facilities its in 20 operates campuses, 10 of which are located in the city centre.
