Main Campus



The FAITH Conference will be organized as a three-day event between the 5th and the 7th of August 2024 under the premises of Canakkale Onsekiz Mart University (COMU) in Çanakkale, Türkiye. Çanakkale, which has lands on both Asia and Europe continents, is located in the western coast of Türkiye, alongside the Dardanelles connecting the Sea of Marmara to the Aegean Sea. The photo above shows the beautiful view of the Dardanelles from the main campus. In addition, Çanakkale is home to the ancient Troy city, which is listed under UNESCO World Heritage Convention.

The Auditorium



COMU, with its 48.309 students, is a modern state university and operates its facilities in 20 campuses, 10 of which are located in the city centre. The FAITH conference will be organized at Troia Convention Centre located at the main campus (Terzioğlu Campus) of the university. The convention centre hosts an auditorium (seated for 512 people) along with 4 concurrent session rooms (each seated for 135 people). The photo shows the auditorium.

Conference Objectives

This conference aims to highlight innovative research and practical applications that support the establishment of minimum standards for academic integrity in higher education institutions. Our goal is to foster a dialogue that leads to effective strategies to prevent cheating behaviors, supports individuals impacted by academic dishonesty, and addresses the ethical implementation of Generative AI in academic contexts.

Conference Topics

We specifically invite researchers, educators, policymakers, and practitioners to submit papers related to the following themes; however, other relevant topics that address the objectives of the conference are also welcome.

- **Academic Integrity Policies:** Innovations in national and institutional policies.
- **Pedagogical Approaches to Academic Integrity:** Effective teaching methods and curricular innovations.
- **Supporting Victims of Academic Misconduct:** Resources and tools for individuals impacted by academic dishonesty.
- **GenAI and Academic Integrity:** Ethical challenges and solutions in using AI tools in academic settings.
- **Ethical Assessment in the Age of AI:** Strategies for maintaining integrity in evaluation and assessment processes.

Submission Guidelines

- Structured abstracts should be between 500 to 800 words including references, clearly outlining the research question, methodology, results/findings, and implications for academic integrity.
